Distance Learning Plan 2024-25

Eagletown will be using a two tier approach to offer instruction to students in case of emergency or school closure. The first tier is providing learning packets that focus on core subjects, making sure that packets are developmentally/grade appropriate and recognize the goals/objectives of the students that have Individual Education Plans. Materials will be aligned with Oklahoma Academic Standards. Students will be monitored biweekly by classroom teachers via telephone, social media and email. These students will be counted as in attendance at Eagletown School as long as they actively communicate with teachers and complete assignments.

The second tier is to provide Distance Learning for those students that have internet access. We will primarily utilize a software program called Edgenuity to cover core subjects. This program is aligned with Oklahoma Academic Standards and serves First Grade through 12. Below are other resources Eagletown School will utilize for Distance Learning.

PK-4th Grade: ABC Mouse, Starfall, Accelerated Reading and Math, Scholastic and OETA tv.

5th-8th Grade: Accelerated Math and Reading, Moby Max, Typing.com, and Newsela.com.

9th-12th Grade: Accelerated Math and Reading

Students participating in Distance Learning will be counted in attendance at Eagletown School. This can be monitored by how long they are logged into the Edgenuity Program.

Professional Development will be provided to all staff in the area of Digital Teaching and Learning to help accomplish our goals.

Credit may be given in courses that have been completed successfully on Edgenuity.

Any student participating in Distance Learning will have the opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities as long as they are successfully completing assignments.

Communication between all parties is crucial to the success of our Distance Learning program. Each teacher is responsible for contacting each parent/student enrolled in their class both virtually and through other technological means and stay in contact with each parent/student throughout the duration emergency or closure.
